Participant Feedback

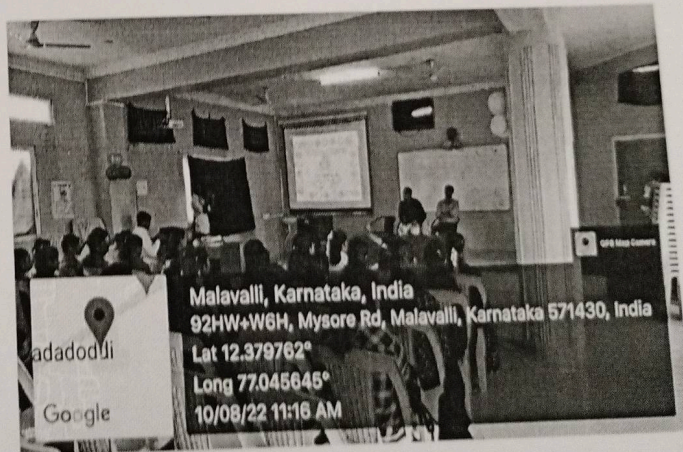
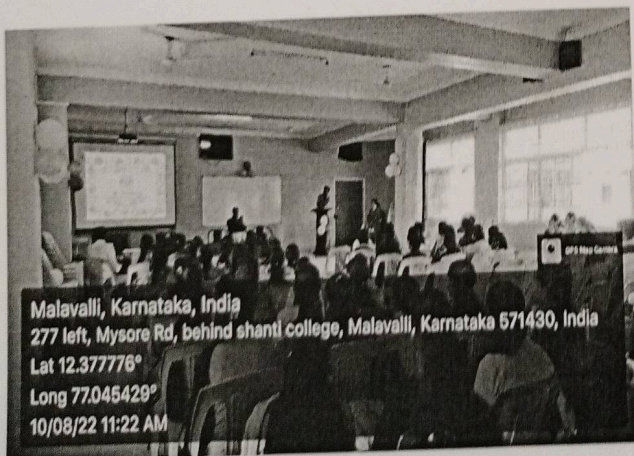
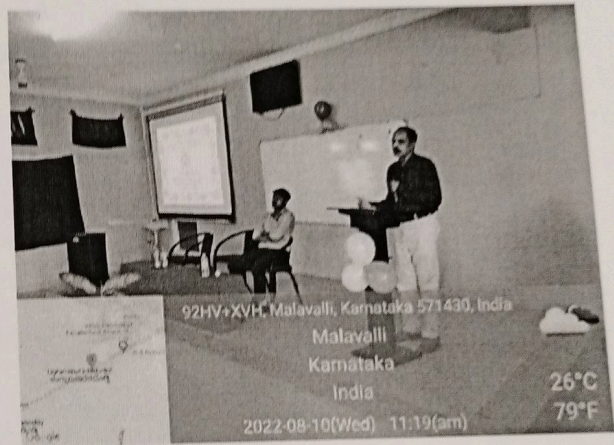
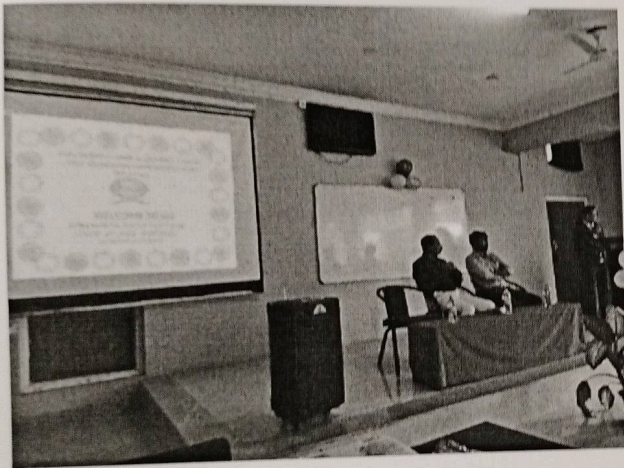
Feedback was collected from the participants to assess the effectiveness of the workshop. The majority of the students found the workshop highly beneficial and informative. Some key feedback points included:
