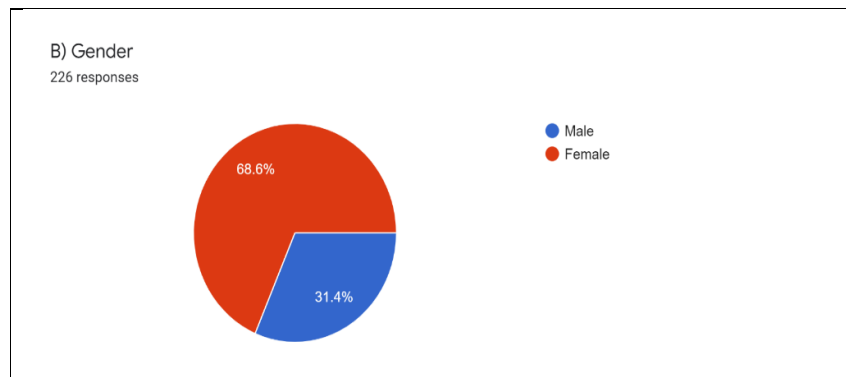

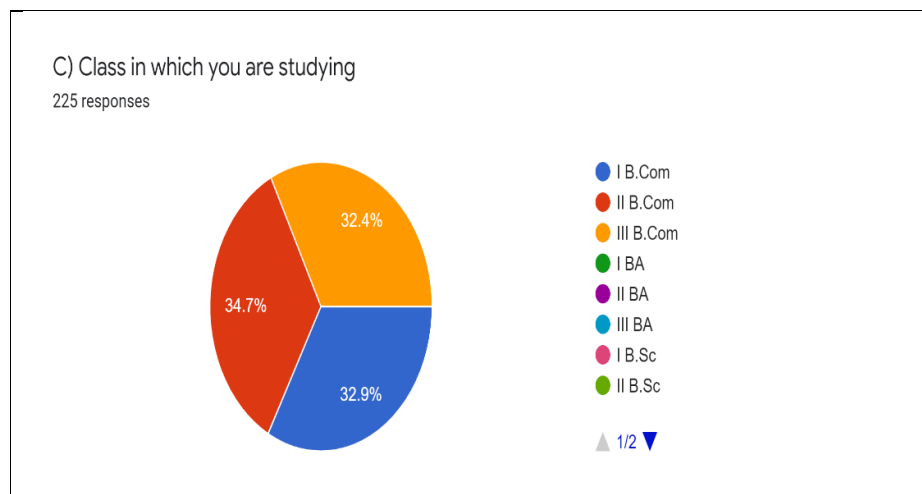


Total respondents filled the google form was 226. Among them 155 (68.6%) were female and remaining 71 (31.4%) were male students.

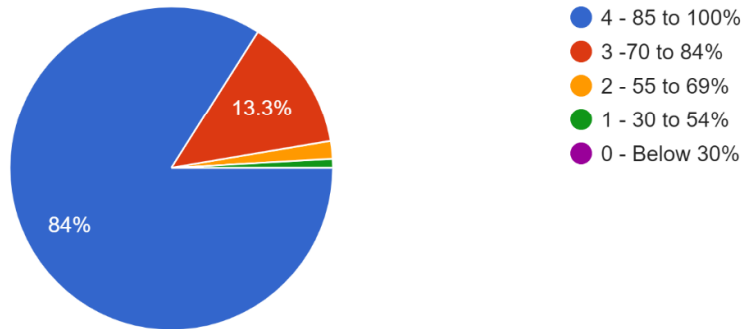

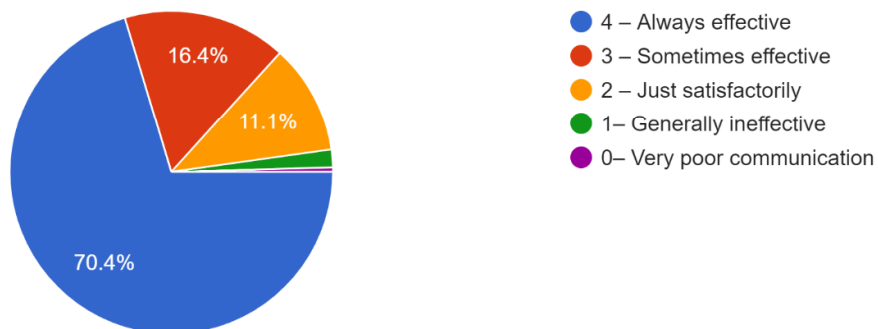

About communication of the teacher 70.4% of the respondents opined it was always effective, 16.4% said sometimes effective and 11.1% feels it is just satisfactory.

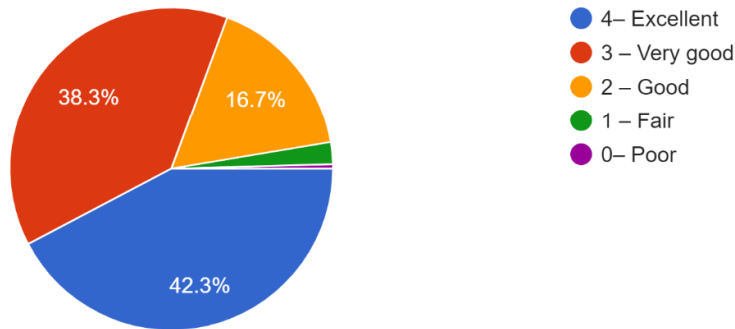

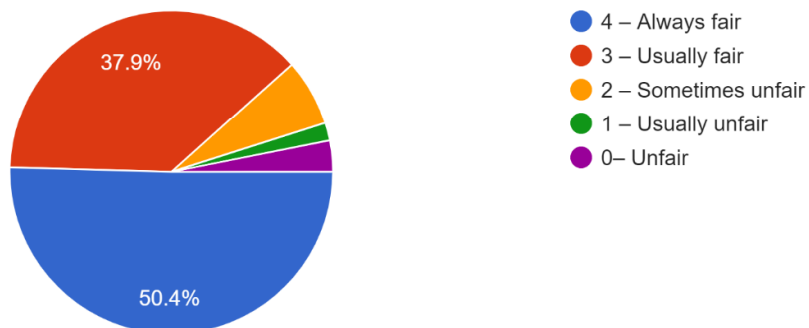
With regard to teachers approach on teaching 42.3% of the respondents expressed it was excellent, 38.3% said it was very good and 16.7% felt it was good.

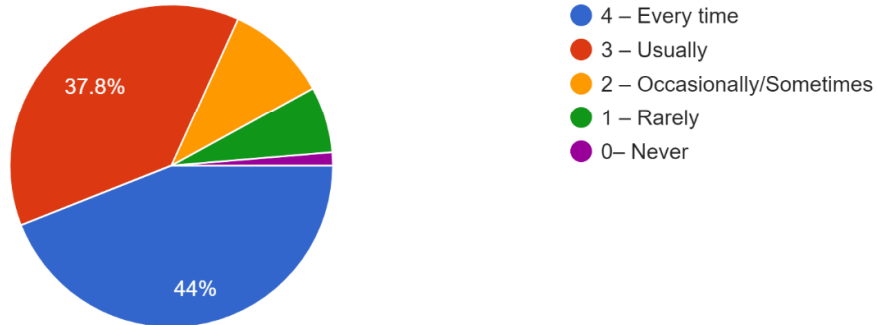

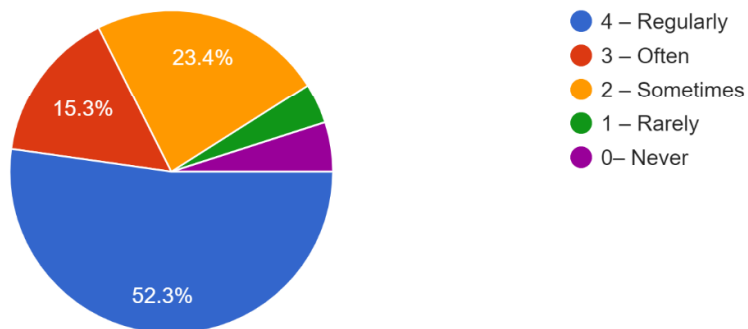

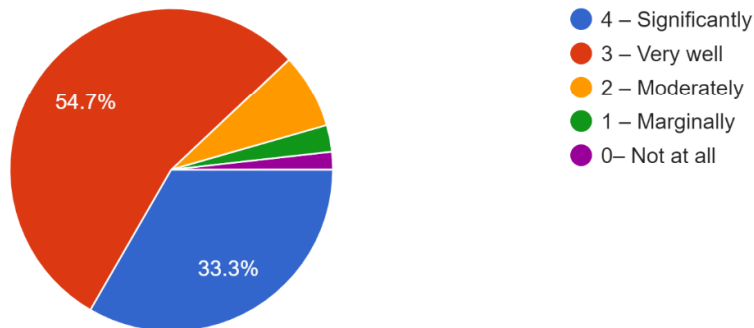

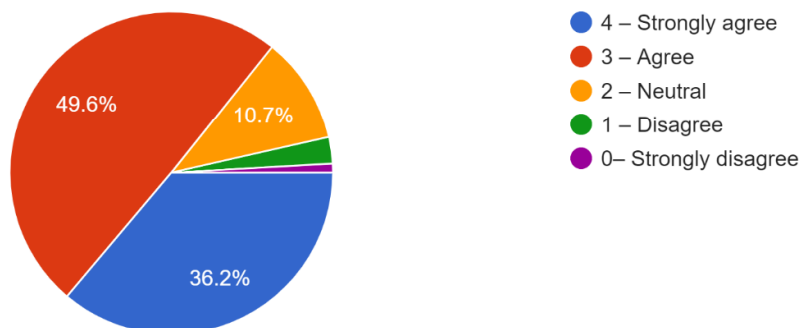

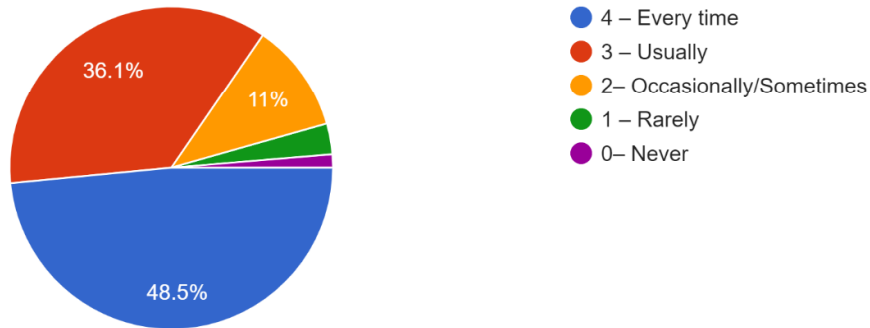

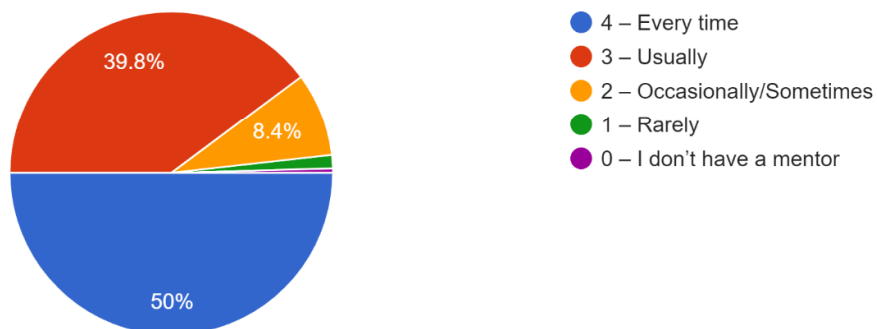

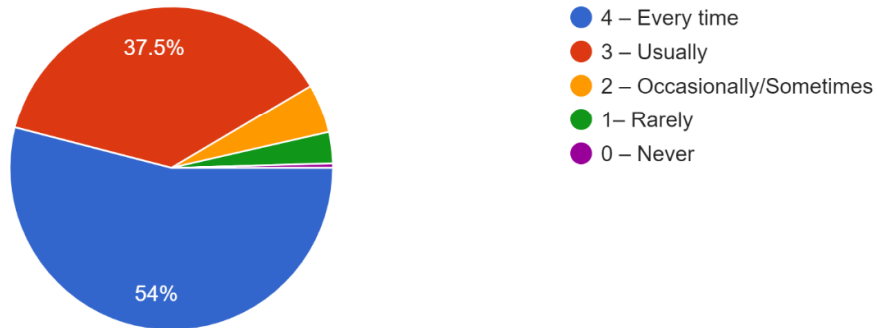

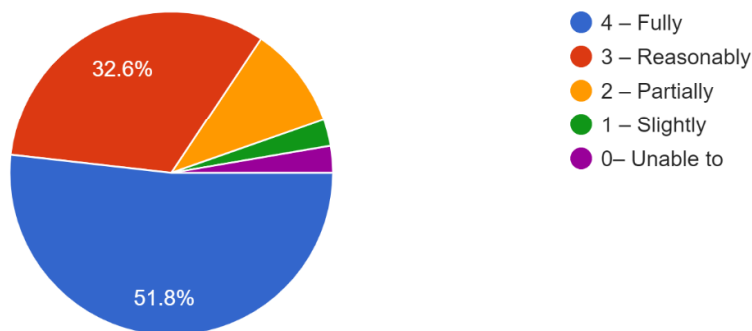

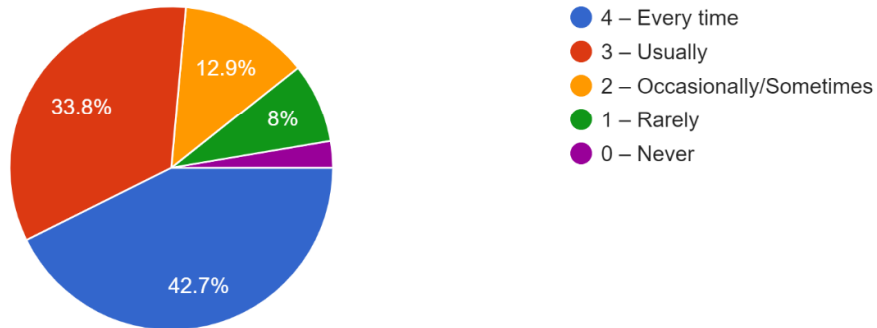

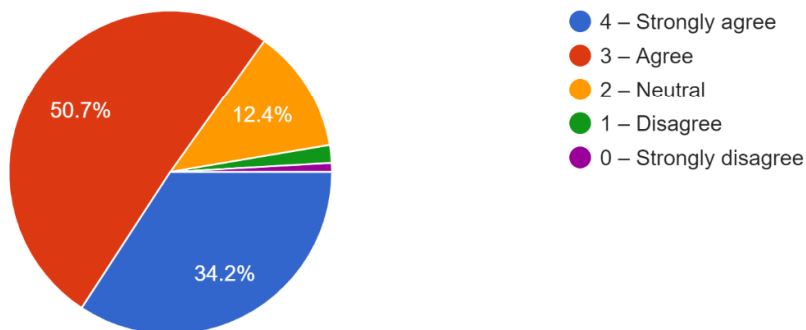

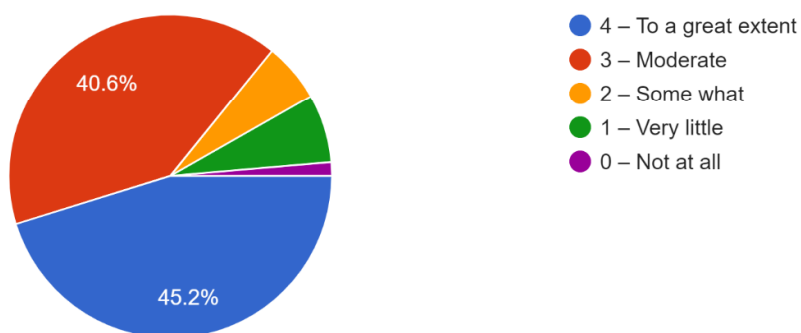

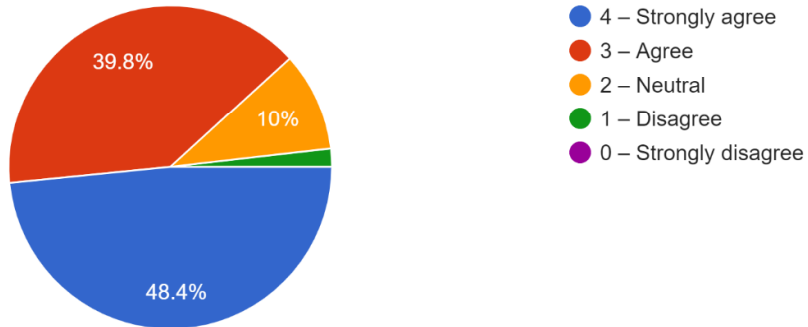

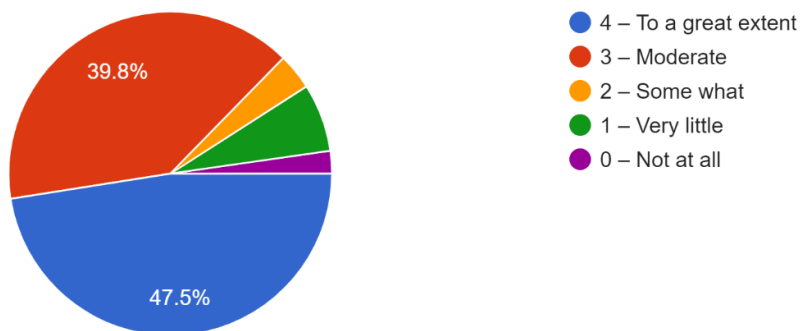

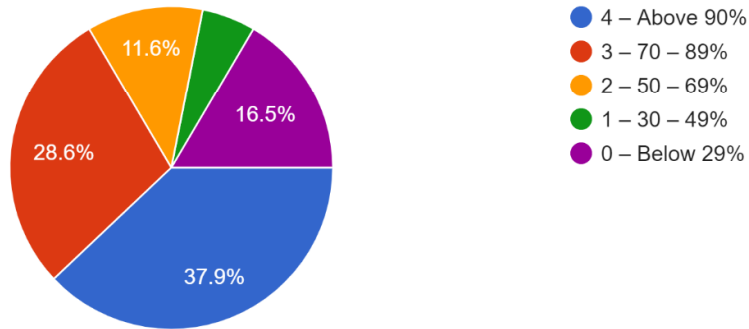

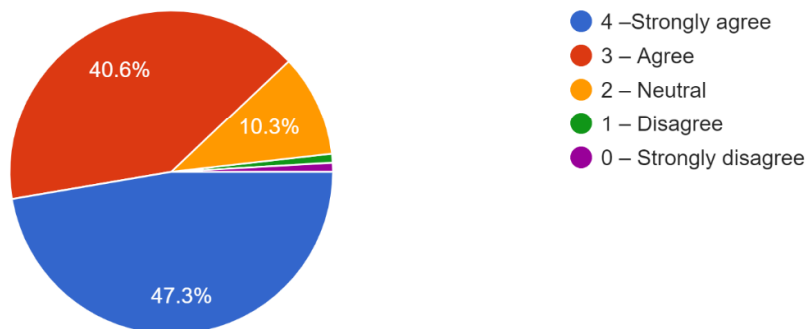
